
Loosen the upper attachments. Remove the original shock absorbers from the car.



Assemble the top mounts according to Fig 1. Apply a small amount of Loctite 2701 to the M8 bolts (2) and install in the rear top mount. Tighten the bolts to 15 Nm.

6

Assemble the front shock absorber according to Fig 2: Install the helper spring (3), the spring support (4), the main spring (5) and the spring retainer (6). Fit the top mount (7) to the shock absorber and install the washer (8), the M10 bolt (9) and the lock nut (10). Orientation of the top mount should be according to Fig 3. Tighten the lock nut to 70 Nm. The bearing spacers (11) will be installed in a later step.





7

Install the Öhlins shock absorber to the vehicle starting with the top mount/upper attachment. The adjusters should be pointing towards the outside of the vehicle.

Note!

Please note that the shock absorbers are left and right. The shock absorber marked MEV 1X00 should be fitted on the left hand side of the vehicle. The shock absorber marked MEV 2X00 should be fitted to the right hand side of the vehicle.

Hold the bearing spacers (11) in place and fit the shock absorber to the lower attachment/ control arm

Note!


Make sure that all bolts are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the strut when it is being fully compressed or extended. Test this over the whole steering range from lock to lock. Pay extra attention at the upper control arm of the vehicle, so that it does not interfere with the shock absorber reservoir according to fig 4. Some of the original bolts need to be replaced when removed. See the service manual for your vehicle or contact an Öhlins dealer.

Make sure that all removed parts are reinstalled in the same way as they were before the installation of the Öhlins shock absorber.



Tighten the lock nut to 70 Nm. The bearing spacers (11) will be installed in a later step.






